KS2 2014 - 2019: 78% of the time Y6 PP pupils equal to or better than school non-PP pupils
78% of the time Y6 PP equal to or better than national PP pupils (2014-2019)

- From 2015 to 2016 in 2 out of 3 subjects (writing and maths) school pupil premium outcomes improved, ie. in school gap closed
- From 2016 to 2017 in 2 out of 3 subjects (reading and maths) school pupil premium outcomes improved, ie. in school gap closed
- 2015 to 2017 saw steadily improving outcomes for pupil premium children at KS2 (Y6)
- 2017 was the first year that pupil premium children out-performed their school non-pupil premium peers in all three tested subjects – reading, writing and maths
- In 2018 pupil premium children in school outperformed non-PP children in school in 2 out of 3 subjects (maths and writing)
- In 2019 pupil premium children in school outperformed non-PP children in school in all 3 core subjects

SUBJECT BREAKDOWN 2014 - 2019:

- **READING:** 67% of the time, pupil premium performance was equal to or better than school non-pupil premium children
- **WRITING:** 100% of the time, pupil premium performance was equal to or better than school non-pupil premium children
- **MATHS:** 67% of the time, pupil premium performance was equal to or better than school non-pupil premium children
