Our topic this term is 'Memory Box'.



Within this topic we will be looking at toys, travel and transport from the past and present.

For the homework project this half term, we would like Year 1 children to choose one of the following ideas:

1. Find and write down 10 amazing facts about how travel and transport has changed.
2. Write some questions and interview someone in your family about which toys they had when they were a child.
3. Design and make a moving toy (this can be as simple as a split pin toy) or a car, bus, bicycle or any other way of transport.
4. Create a travel & transport board / card game.
5. Compose and recite a song about travel and transport.
6. Maths - Record the colour of 20 cars that go by. Use a tally chart to record the results and then display them as a simple pictogram or bar chart.
7. Or you can you think of your own activity to link with how travel and transport has changed? This can be anything you like.

Children need to be able to explain their project and what they researched. Please can you support your child with their work, but not complete their homework for them as they will need to present it to the class.

Your projects are due in on Monday 10th February 2020. There will also be a presentation opportunity for parents/carers on Tuesday 11th February 2020.
