



Year 2 SUMMER TERM FORECAST 2021



WELCOME BACK to the Summer Term

Get set for a busy term ahead! For the first few weeks we'll be focusing on settling back into school. We'll also be getting stuck into our Creative Curriculum topics and have some fun workshops and days planned.

MATHS

This term the children will be completing the topics:

1. Measurement including mass, capacity, temperature and length
2. Time
3. Position and Rotation
4. Arithmetic practice.
5. Securing number facts, Relationships & Calculating

We will review addition and subtraction calculation strategies, revising partitioning . We will continue to develop multiplication, division and problem solving skills.

Homework: In addition to homework and using Mathletics, it is also beneficial to continue to practice real life problems with your child, involving time, money & measure.

English

We will focus on the following units of work this term:

- Non chronological report (non fiction)
- Story writing
- Recounts (diary writing)
- Letter writing

This work will be continuing to work around the story of 'Pirates and Coastlines' . We will be reading a range of pirate themed books. This term we will be focusing on coastal features and famous pirates. After half term we will be moving onto Pirate Cruncher (Fiction book).

Grammar: Consistent use of punctuation is essential and children should be joining their handwriting. Those children writing at length will be introduced to writing in paragraphs in order to organise their work. **Spellings:** Please continue to support your child to learn their weekly spellings.

Reading: Your child should continue to read aloud daily to an adult. Please write a comment in your child's reading record, otherwise books may not be changed. Some children have now completed the school's reading scheme and are now 'free readers'. This means they can choose a book from the class library. Reading scheme books should be brought into school on their designated day.

OUR TOPICS

Creative Curriculum: We will start by looking at Metacognition. This will be a continuation from Growth Mind-set. During these lessons we will be focusing on Self improvement and Self Reflection , Being Resilient and how to respond to mistakes.

In our next topic on Pirates and Coastlines, we will continuing to learn all about the coastline features, reading maps, learning about the different continents and oceans.

RE The children will be learning about the topic 'Baptism and Marriage'. There will be a focus on the importance of these sacraments. Later in the Summer Term the children will learn about another religion 'Hindiusm'.

ICT A variety of ICT tasks are integrated into our daily learning, each week the children have opportunities to use computers, laptops and iPads to support their learning. In addition we will focus on word processing to make invitations and menus.

PE : We will be focusing on key basic skills this term such as skipping, jumping, teamwork and catching. We will be continuing to take regular brain breaks in between lessons. These brain breaks given children to dance and move around.

SCIENCE

We will be looking at healthy eating, growing and life cycles. After half term we will be moving onto experiments and working scientifically. Children will be encouraged to plan and complete their own experiments.

Homework

Homework will be set on Friday and needs to be completed by Wednesday the following week. On top of this children will need to learn their weekly spellings. Please use the spelling grids to support you.
