Syllabus Overview



Rationale	<p>Enable pupils to express their ideas and thoughts in another language and understand and respond to its speakers. Provide opportunities to learn new ways of thinking. Provide the foundation for learning additional languages.</p> <p>A wide range of happy and rich memories in Italian formed through engaging and exciting experiences driven through vehicles that enhance children’s awareness of their abilities and strengths as a learner.</p>
Approach	<p>CLIL = Content and Language Integrated Learning, it means doing subjects with a different language, Italian.</p> <p>TPR= Total Physical Response, a language teaching method developed by James Asher. It is based on the coordination of language and physical movement. In TPR, instructors give students commands in the target language with body movements, and students respond with whole-body actions.</p> <p>STORYTELLING - ROLE PLAY – CROSS-CURRICULAR APPROACH</p>

EYFS

Pupils in EYFS learn Italian colours, numbers and greetings through songs, games, and storytelling. Children are involved in an emotional environment and they are engaged in kinaesthetic learning activities. The pupil centre approach is based on participative, active, and communicative teaching, including non-verbal expressions.
